CSCOPE – TI for ELA Grade 9: Unit 2 “Visions & Vistas”

Evaluate the credibility of a web site by analyzing its content and structure. ©2008, TESCCC

Technology Integration Activity:

Participants will become familiar with the criteria for evaluating web sites by completing the University of North Carolina's Evaluating Web Sites Tutorial. The tutorial provides an overview of the criteria used to evaluate informational web sites and their sources. After completing the tutorial, participants will know how to judge the validity and accuracy of informational web sites. Participants will then create their own web site evaluation rubric using RCampus's Collaborative Learning Environment Tools.

Create a movie trailer contrasting the traits and motivations of a protagonist and an antagonist. Describe the type of conflict that they each have within themselves or between one another or both. ©2008, TESCCC

Technology Integration Activity:

Trailers are used to motivate, intrigue, and excite audiences into attending a movie's premier. Teachers can generate the same motivation, intrigue, and excitement with their students by creating a character movie trailer. In this session, participants will create a character movie trailer using Windows Movie Maker. Participants will learn how to design the visual layout of the trailer, scene by scene, using storyboards. Technical skills such as inserting video clips, editing background music files, and adding title overlays will also be covered. Character trailers will be uploaded to Teacher Tube for future reference.
